WET OP SPESIALE ONDERSOEKEENHEDE EN SPESIALE TRIBUNALE, 1996 (WET NO. 74 VAN 1996): WYSIGING VAN PROKLAMASIE 244 VAN 2025

Hierby wysig ek, kragtens artikel 2(4) van die Wet op Spesiale Ondersoekeenhede en Spesiale Tribunale, 1996 (Wet No. 74 van 1996), Proklamasie Kennisgewing 244 van 2025 (hierna die "oorspronklike Proklamasie" genoem), deur—

- (a) die datum "1 Januarie 2022" (wat in beide gevalle voorkom) in die vierde paraagraaf van die oorspronklike Proklamasie, te vervang met die datum "5 Junie 2020";
- (b) die tydperk bedoel in die vierde paragraaf van die liggaam van die oorspronklike Proklamasie te verleng na die datum van publikasie van die gewysigde Proklamasie; en
- (c) die invoeging van die volgende paragraawe in die Bylae tot die oorspronklike Proklamasie:
 - (cc) Bodnommer GKM 43-19/20, vir die lewer en aflewering van skootrekenaars en tafelrekenaars; en
 - (dd) Bodnommer GKM 14-20/21, vir die lewering en hernuwing van sagtewarelisensies.

REQUEST FOR COMMENTS/INPUTS FROM DIRECTLY AFFECTED GROUPS IN THE RED MEAT INDUSTRY

REQUEST FOR THE CONTINUATION OF STATUTORY MEASURES RELATING TO LEVIES, RECORDS & RETURNS AND REGISTRATIONS ON CATTLE, GOATS, SHEEP AND RED MEAT IN TERMS OF THE MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS ACT (ACT No. 47 OF 1996, as amended)

It is hereby made known that, in terms of Section 11 of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act, 1996 (Act No.47 of 1996) (MAP Act), the Minister of Agriculture has received a request from the red meat industry for the continuation of statutory measures relating to levies, registration, the keeping of records and the rendering of returns. The Red Meat and Livestock Primary Cluster (RMLPC) is the applicant, which is comprised of the Red Meat Producers' Organisation (RPO), Red Meat Abattoirs Association (RMAA), South African Feedlot Association (SAFA) and African Farmers Association of South Africa Red Meat Chapter (AFASA RMC), applied for the continuation of the statutory measures on cattle, goats, sheep and red meat. These statutory measures will be administered by the Red Meat Industry Services (RMIS) NPC.

The current statutory measures (levies, registrations and records & returns) in the red meat industry will expire on 4 November 2026. The RMLPC requests ministerial approval for the continuation of the statutory measures for a new period of four years, from 5 November 2026 to lapse on 4 November 2030. The proposed statutory measures are as follows:

- A statutory levy in terms of section 15 of the MAP Act;
- Records and returns in terms of section 18 of the MAP Act; and
- Registrations in terms of section 19 of the MAP Act.
